- 4. I can recollect that part of the conversation was in relation to various possible modes and areas of deep collaboration between The Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Institute of Education.

5. As the event occurred almost a year ago, at present I do not have any

specific recollection of what was said at the dinner, except that it did result in

agreement on a joint letter, which was signed and dated two days later on

April 19, 2006, from President Paul Morris of the Hong Kong Institute of

Education and me addressed to Dr. Alice Lam, Chairman of the University

Grants Committee, proposing five additional areas of deep collaboration

between the two institutions (a copy of the joint letter is attached). There

was no mention of a merger in this joint letter.

6. I also had no recollection or impression that the question of "merger", as

defined in Hong Kong Higher Education Integration Matters: A Report of the

Institutional Integration Working Party of the University Grants Committee

March 2004, was discussed at that dinner. My recollection and impression

was that the question of "merger" was not discussed.
